## 2. Summary of main results



- ✓ 6 MA curricula in Finance were reformed
- ✓ Materials for 48 courses were updated/newly developed.
- √ 48 teachers were trained in didactics and current topics in Finance
- ✓ Successful implementation of the reformed MA programmes since the winter term 2019
- ✓ Sustainability strategies were developed and follow-up cooperation agreements were signed
