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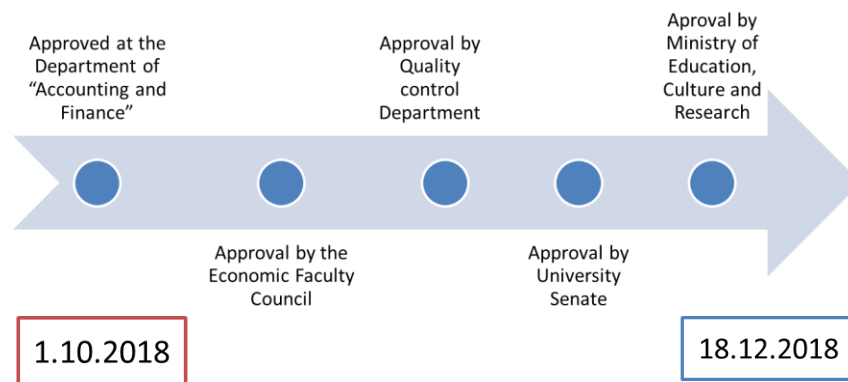


# Curriculum Modifications

8 new curricula and Course Packages developed (updated courses of lectures, practical exercises and PP presentations in Moodle Platform)

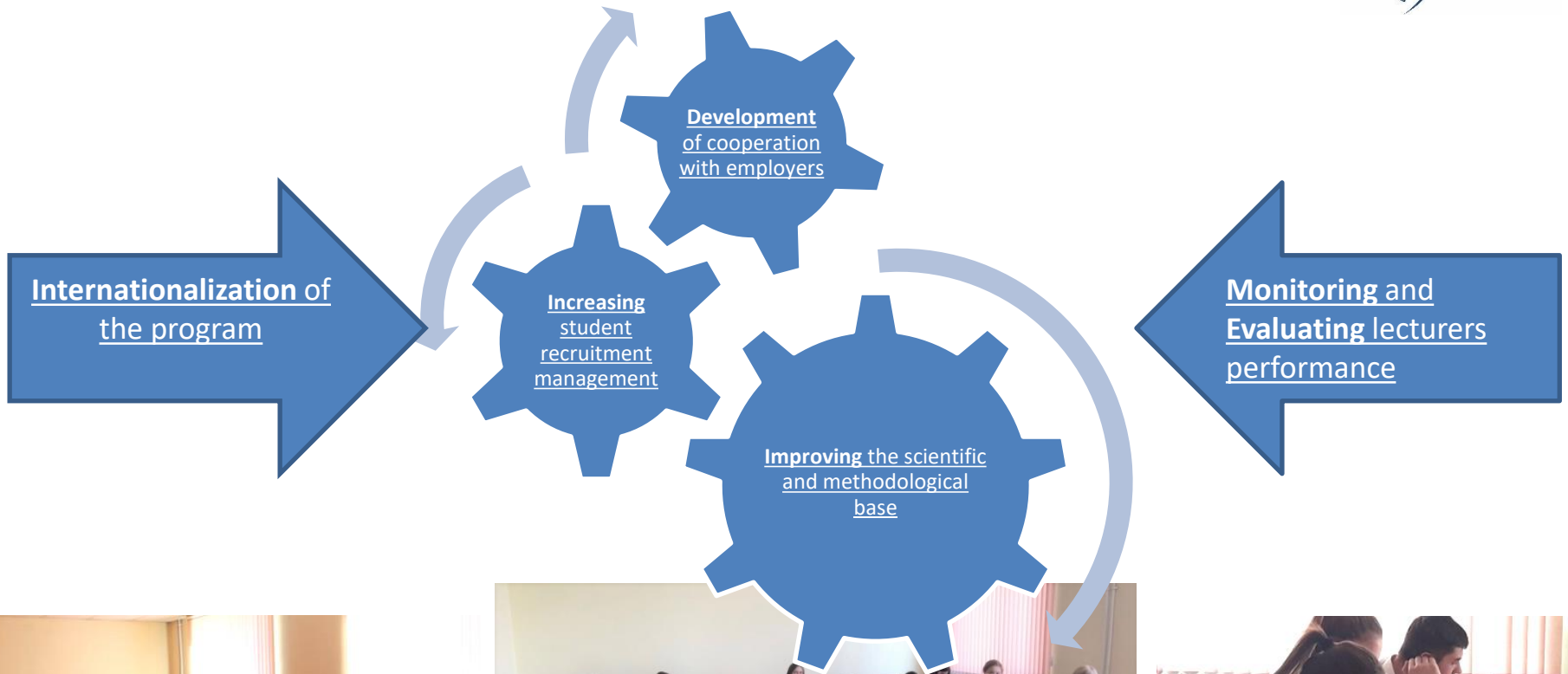
200 new books were purchased
