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REFINE Project: Overview of Reformed Master Programmes

As part of the Erasmus+ Capacity Building in Higher Education Project “*Reforming Master Programmes in Finance in Armenia and Moldova*” (REFINE, 2017-2020) six Master (MA) programmes in Finance at Armenian and Moldovan universities were successfully reformed.

The reforms for instance took into account the evolving local labour market requirements and latest international trends in Finance. The implemented measures amongst others included curriculum reforms, advanced trainings for university teachers and the development of new or updated course materials.
